Up early for some quiet time with God and to finish last God's Servant in Northern Ireland minute packing, thoughts are running through my head. Hayden arrives at 8:30 AM to take me to the God's Servant in Northern Ireland airport. Hayden and I met about three months ago and established a good friendship. He and his fiancée Ashley are the owners of CORE Nutrition in Elk Grove. When I heard that they were driving in every day from Lodi to Elk Grove (20 miles each way), I felt lead to ask them to house sit for me. God's Servant in Northern Ireland This past week has been busy with Vacation Bible School (Summer Mega Camp) at First Baptist Church of Elk Grove. God's Servant in Northern Ireland There were 550 kids and 200

volunteers. I treated four God's Servant in Northern Ireland or five kids every day, mostly for abrasions and other minor medical issues. I also had Cine (pronounced Sinay), my 7 year old daughter, all week God's Servant in Northern Ireland and wanted to spend as much time as God's Servant in Northern Ireland I could with her and pack at the same time. Whew!

The flight to LAX was uneventful. Sharon (an adult team member) met me at God's Servant in Northern Ireland baggage claim and we had lunch together at Encounters, the domed, themed restaurant at LAX built in the 1960s. Afterward Trisha (the other adult team member) and two other youth team members, LeAnn and Justyna, pick us up. We are meeting as a team for the first time. After the three other youth team members, Kathryn, Timothy, and Madelynne appear and their parents say goodbye, we go into a classroom at Fairview Heights Baptist Church in Inglewood, CA. We have an interesting group. Only God knows the reason He brought these eight different individuals together. We have Sharon, Trisha, Kathryn, LeAnn, Madelynne, Timothy, Justyna and myself—three adults and five teenagers ages 16-18. I'm always amazed at how God brings different people together, with different personalities and goals from different parts God's Servant in Northern Ireland of the world to accomplish and strive towards His goal, which results in honoring Him and enhancing His kingdom.
